## Rationale for a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

- Representation and participation of SMEs in the PPE and textile care sector in Europe in standardisation-related activities is insufficient
- Absence of a European association representing the interests of SMEs in PPE and textile care
- Voice of SMEs in this sector remained unheard before SBS started to engage in this sector

### Why now?

- The sector is facing major changes due to the new European legislative framework, and consequently with regard to standardisation in support of this new legislation.
- Regulation 2016/425 (PPE)
- Regulation 2017/745 (Medical Devices)

- Elaborate consensus-based positions on SME issues relevant to sectoral legislation and standardization
- Inform members about newly published legislations and standards
- Engage in communication with legislators and standardisation bodies as well as Notified Bodies
